



REQUIREMENTS

To ensure that your clubs benefits as much as possible and your participants all have an enjoyable experience, Shooting Australia is asking that your club provides the following:

- **Range availability on a day during May** – We are aiming to have high attendance at every club during *National Come and Try May*. Ensuring that your club and range is available and presentable will ensure that participants enjoy all the facilities available at your club.
- **Have a friendly person to represent the club and help new people feel welcome as they enter** – You only get to make one first impression. A welcoming smile and engaging personality will draw in participants and make them feel welcome at your club.
- **Within seven days of event, provide basic information of those who attended in the Excel form provided (Name, email, suburb, age, gender)** – We use this information to provide statistics to the Sport Australia and to measure the success of the day. No personal information is shared with third parties.
- **Appropriate range staff to ensure safe sessions are conducted** – Many of the participants will be visiting a gun club for the first time. Having staff who can help participants attend the range safely and learn the positive culture of our sport will help add to their experience and keep everyone safe.
- **Provide photos from your event to help celebrate the sport around the country** – We all love a selfie! We want to share our sport to the Australian community. By posting photos to your club website and social media goes a long way to showing just how enjoyable our sport is. We will also be using your photos on our social media and website too.
- **Agree to these requirements** – We acknowledge that *National Come and Try May* will involve a lot of work. Shooting Australia will be available to assist your club through the process but first, we need to know that you agree to these requirements. There will be an opportunity to agree to these requirements in the registration form.
